Blackberries

Blackberries grow on thorny, woody bushes called brambles or cases. The plants grow year round but the fruit is best in the spring and summer months. Blackberries have a variety of names including brambleborries, dewberries, and thimbleborries. Blackberries, like raspberries, are actually made up of a cluster of tiny fruits, called drupelets. Each berry has about 80 to 100 drupelets.

Blueberries

Also called star berries and huckleberries, blueberries are the edible, bluish berry that grows on a shrub. Blueberries can be eaten in a variety of ways. You can put them in waffles, salads, cereal and patmeal. They can also be used to make juice, smoothles or just eaten by themselves.

Did you know? Some varieties of blueberry plants can produce up to 5 pounds of berries per year.
