As we move forward with the Chester ISD-COVID-19 school closure, there are a few changes and developments that need to be communicated with each of you.

During this time, we understand the importance and necessity to care for yourself and loved ones as a priority. Food service is of utmost importance to us during this time. We do have a major change to food service distribution as follows:

- WEEK OF MARCH 23-26TH (Monday-Thursday) FOOD PICK UP WILL BE FROM 8-10 DAILY
- STARTING WEEK OF MARCH 30TH- APRIL 9TH FOOD MAY BE PICKED UP ON MONDAY ONLY
- STUDENTS MUST BE IN VEHICLE FOR FOOD TO BE DISTRIBUTED
- FIVE DAYS WORTH OF MEALS WILL BE GIVEN AT THIS ONE TIME: FIVE BREAKFAST MEALS AND FIVE LUNCHES PER STUDENT
- PICK-UP FROM **CHESTER ISD** DURING THE FOLLOWING WINDOW ONLY: 8:00-10:00.

Instructional packets will be paper format with additional online resources as needed. **These will be available for pick-up in front of the administration building.** NO VISITORS ARE ALLOWED TO ENTER A BUILDING.

- INSTRUCTIONAL PACKETS ARE AVAILABLE ON MONDAY, MARCH 23RD ONLY:
- PACKETS ARE AVAILABLE DURING SAME HOURS AS FOOD DISTRIBUTION: 8:00-10:00
- FOR INSTRUCTIONAL ASSISTANCE YOU MAY EMAIL STAFF DIRECTLY.
- INSTRUCTIONAL PACKETS ARE NOT TO BE RETURNED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE TO PROTECT FROM THE SPREAD OF ANY GERMS/VIRUSES. (Please keep them until we return to school or other instructions are given)
